# Frequently Asked Questions

**Q: We have food that has been donated, can we bring it in?**

A: Due to our state catering license we cannot allow any outside food or beverage brought into the resort. Many schools opt to provide students with a snack while on the bus to the resort.

**Q: How many students are required to hold our event at the Double JJ Resort?**

A: The minimum amount of students required is 50.

**Q: What do we need to do first to secure our date?**

A: To secure your date you would need to make a deposit and then sign the Letter of Agreement we set up for you. The Letter of Agreement will state the following:

- Date of your event
- Package price per student and chaperone
- What is included in your package
- Minimum number of students
- Itinerary

**Q: What type of deposit do you require and what are the payment options?**

A: We require a \$2,000 deposit. 90 days prior to your event we ask for 80% of the estimated balance (less the deposit), and one week prior to your arrival we ask for payment to be made in full.

**Q: Do you allow for more than one school at a time?**

A: We have a rotation schedule, which means if we have two schools in one night we rotate the events and activities accordingly so the different schools will not be in the same building at the same time. Two schools is also the maximum we allow.



**Q: What are the different areas of the resort?**

A: We have three areas of the resort, allowing for different ‘Mystery’ locations.

Resort areas include:

- **Frontier** - *Northernmost portion of the resort*  
Major attractions include Indoor Waterpark, Golf Course, Thoroughbred Dining and Spirits, and the Wyatt/Maverick rooms.
- **Ranch** - *Center portion of the resort*  
Includes the Rodeo Arena, Wagon Wheel and the Chuck Wagon.
- **Back Forty** - *Southernmost portion of the resort*  
Attractions include Old West Town, Dancehall and the Swimmin’ Hole (outdoor water activity center).

**Q: Is each location within walking distance?**

A The three locations are located along a two mile stretch. We don’t recommend the schools walk to the different areas. The school is responsible for providing transportation to each location, provided their activities/events are in different locations of the resort.

**Q: At what locations do the different activities/events take place?**

A: This chart will help you visualize where different activities take place:

**Q: Can we have more than one activity going on at once?**

A: Yes! We actually encourage having activities running simultaneously. For instance, maybe not every student would be interested in the Waterpark, so during the Waterpark time frame you could have the Mechanical Bull and the Arcade available as well.

**Q: Can we stay longer in the Waterpark?**

A: It is possible; there are a few different factors that would determine this possibility. However, we don't recommend the extra time in the Waterpark due to advice given from past schools. The students tend to lose interest and are ready to move on after two hours of swimming.

**Q: What time would our event start and end? How long is the event?**

A: We customize your start and end time according to your schedule. We understand that all schools have different time frames and are traveling different distances to get here. The length of the event can be as long or as short as your group decides. We recommend at least four hours in order for the students to enjoy the activities and not feel rushed. On average, most schools stay about 6-8 hours and have no problem filling that amount of time with an eventful night of entertainment.

**Q: Can we bring in outside vendors such as photobooths, tattoo artists, etc.?**

A You are more than welcome to bring in outside vendors and entertainment attractions. Just be sure to let us know when and where you plan to have these items during your event. Also, let us know what time/date a company may be delivering an attraction.



**Q: Do you provide decorations or can we bring in our own?**

A: We do not provide any decorations. You are more than welcome to bring in your own, however, they cannot be put up until the start time for your group in that venue location and must be removed before the end time for your group in that venue location. We request no candles or confetti be used for decorations. Due to moving to varied locations you may feel they are not practical.

**Q: When do we need to have all our details finalized?**

A: We like to have all the minor details finalized at least 90 days prior to your event. This gives us plenty of time to communicate with our staff. We recommend setting a time to do a final walk through with our activity and our food and beverage staff about 30 days prior to your event. This helps ensure everyone is on the same page and all questions are answered.

# Things to Know

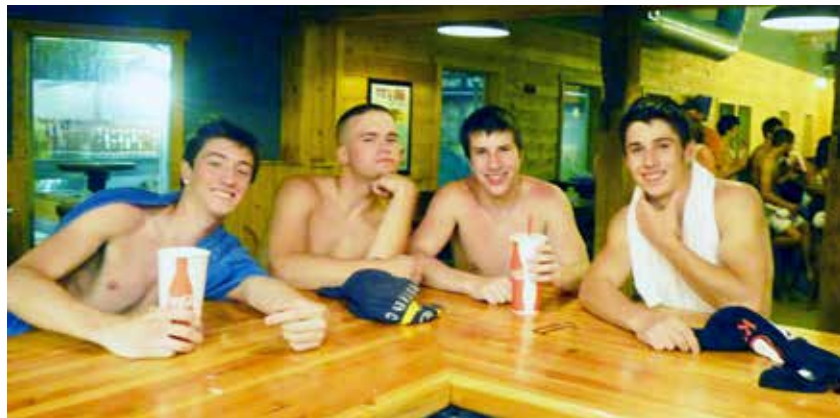
**1. Final Detail Appointments** We strongly encourage your committee to take advantage of scheduling an appointment for a final walk through of the event. In our experience, we have found this appointment to be the key to success. This appointment allows our team to ask questions, suggest options and for you to provide us with the final details of your expectations. Please be sure to set up this appointment with group sales no later than one week prior to your event. Should you decide to opt out of this, we do require and “Opt Out” form to be filled out for your file.

**2. Time is of the Essence** We understand that there are some circumstances that may delay your arrival. However, with the schedules that are put in place, any delayed arrivals will impact the time frame of your first event location. If you feel you may not be able to meet the scheduled time, you will need to contact your Sales Manager to update the Event Order to reflect a later time frame for that evening, if at all possible.

**3. Transport from Location to Location** It is the responsibility of the school to provide the transportation to and from each location unless pre-arranged hay wagons are part of your event.

**4. Hayrides** We are a ranch and therefore it can be dusty during the hayride. Please be advised that we cannot control the dust but do our best to choose a trail that may reduce this.

**5. Outdoor Events** Being that we are a rather remote location, depending on the weather we may have mosquitos. We recommend bringing bug spray should this be the case.



**6. Weather** Senior Lock In season in Michigan is unpredictable. Due to the wonderful Michigan weather you may want to consider asking the students to bring warmer clothes, jackets, rain gear, etc.

**7. Food and Beverage** Our rule of thumb when serving meals is to initially prep food based on the average consumption of one person. For instance, with a Pizza Buffet we begin by serving enough pizza for each person to have two pieces. If more pizza is needed we will continue to prep and served extra for those that would like to come back for seconds. Therefore we ask that your chaperons monitor the first round to allow everyone to get their first serving.
